All these assessments are provided by [City & Guilds](#) to use as a qualification. The duration of this level was approximately one year, consisting of two semesters, each lasting six months. The cost for one year is around **4,200,000 MMK**, including registration fees, exam fees, & semester fees.

To achieve the Level 3 Technician Diploma in Mechanical Engineering - Maintenance, Installation and Commissioning, learners must achieve **27 credits** from 301 - 302, and a minimum of **27 credits** from 317, 322, 330, 332, 315 of which a minimum of **9 credits** must come from 317 - 322.
